Upcycling opportunities are manifold and include construction material, secondary raw material handicrafts and furniture. The results of plastic upcycling are cleaner natural and human habitats, employment opportunities for local population and better health conditions for communities.

#### **Briquettes from Biomass**

Billions of tons of biomass are generated annually. Biomass can be converted into briquettes and pellets, which are renewable sources of energy that can be used in place of fossil fuels, charcoal and natural gas. Briquette manufacturing opens up new income sources for farmers, significantly reduces health risks compared to burning traditional fuels, and creates employment opportunities for the local population.
